





Comments

Current phone recording setup needs an upgrade due to issues with audio capture. The recordings tend to have insufficient volume levels and experience audio dropout where parts of the sound get lost. Better recording equipment would help resolve these audio quality issues.

I really think that being able to submit lab videos hurt the integrity of the labs. We never had more than 4–5 students on non–lab test days. I believe the students who did not come to lab would go different labs of classes of labs they would skip earlier in the week. I did appreciate the video submission the one week I used it, but I did use the lab time as well. I think being in the lab room and doing work would encourage students to do their own assignments. Two suggestions would be making lab attendances a portion of the mark or making video submission only available to be marked if the student went to the lab.
