Withdrawals

- Appear on your transcript as a “W”
- Do *not* affect:
 - Your GPA
 - The number of times you can attempt the course (3)
 - The number of courses you can fail (2+level)
 - Your B.Eng. competition ranking

A course failure affects all of those!

- Will appear on your transcript as an F
- Will lower your GPA, eligibility for BEng and scholarships
- You will be placed on probation (hold) if you exceed the limit on the number of course failures (2+level); you will be suspended (dismissal) if you fail another course
- You will be unable to finish the program if you exceed the number of attempts at one course (3)

March 20, 2020

- You will have completed most quizzes, the mid-term exam and at least one lab exam
- If you are not doing well, and *certainly* if you are already failing either theory or lab... please:
