Maybe provide a small space under each exercise in the lecture notes so they could be done directly in the notes. Just a suggestion!

planning exercises would be a smart thing to do as i noticed we wasted a lot of time with student confusion and Ed getting his own questions wrong, which no judgement, only human after all. but on a short schedule i think it should be avoided.

The hardest part of this course was Lab 1, due to the steep learning curve. Students didn't feel ready to code at first, but overall, the course became easier as they gained more experience.
