Question 3

Assume the record above was uploaded at 1PM and has a TTL of 1 hour. If it was most recently retrieved from an authoritative name server at 2 PM and from a recursive name server at 3 PM, when should it no longer be considered valid?

Question 5

What do the following MIME types mean?

- 1. video/ogg
- 2. multipart/mixed
- 3. application/octet-stream

Question 6

Your ID should be in a bold font and food name should be a link to a web page about the food (a recipe, the Wikipedia entry, a fan site, etc). You can create the HTML file with any text editor (e.g. Notepad++).
